Robinson R44 helicopters burn AvGas, also known as 100LL. It's a 100 octane leaded fuel. On the day this video was posted, AvGas at my airport cost \$5.52 per gallon. My helicopter burns between 14 and 17 gallons per hour, depending on my flight profile.

A brand-new four-seat Robinson R44 helicopter costs around \$300,000 and can be easily shared by three or four owners.
