When learning how to shoot in manual mode you need to know and understand the "exposure triangle". This is made up of your aperture, shutter speed, and ISO. You use these three components to get your light meter to be at zero. To find your light meter look through your view finder.

What Every Photographer Should Know About Manual Mode

To use manual mode, you have to make artistic choices and play with the shutter speed and the aperture, leaving the ISO as an additive compensation to get the correct exposure. If you want to photograph a road with cars passing by in the middle of the day, you will most likely want a sharp photo so you will use a small aperture.

How to Use Manual Mode to Make Artistic Choices for Your ...

Change your camera setting to manual (M) mode and turn it on. Press and hold down the exposure compensation button while turning the rotating dial until the aperture is the lowest f number it can go. You will be able to see this on the back LCD display.

Setting Up and Shooting in Manual Mode Turn your camera on and then turn the Mode dial to align the M with the indicator line. Select your ISO by pressing the i button on the back of the camera. Press up or down on the Multi-selector to highlight the ISO option, then select OK.

M: Shooting in Manual Mode. You can manually set the shutter speed and aperture to achieve a particular effect. When you press the shutter button halfway, the difference between the standard exposure*, and the selected exposure appears on the LCD monitor. If the difference is more than +/- 2 stops, "-2" or "+2" appears in red.
