SEDATION MONITORING FORM Clinic or Unit:

Moderate (conscious) sedation is a drug-induced depression of consciousness during which patients respond purposefully to verbal commands, either alone or accompanied by light tactile stimulation. No interventions are required to maintain a patent airway, and spontaneous ventilation is adequate. Cardiovascular function is usually maintained.

Moderate sedation, also sometimes referred to as conscious sedation, is a drug-induced depression of consciousness. A patient who has been sedated in this way is relaxed and generally insensitive to pain, but remains awake and able to respond to verbal instruction.

Procedural sedation is the administration of a sedative or dissociative agent to produce a depressed level of consciousness, while maintaining cardiorespiratory function. Hospital Outpatient Prospective Payment System (OPPS): Use ...

These codes are used for conscious sedation and general anesthesia (which renders the patient unconscious during the procedure). Anesthesia coding is essentially different from any other form of coding in the way the anesthesia services are billed. Codes for conscious sedation are found in the medical section.

- Moderate sedation (old terminology conscious sedation or sedation/analgesia): a drug-induced depression of consciousness during which patients respond purposefully to verbal commands (eg, open your eyes either alone or accompanied by light tactile stimulation—a light tap on the shoulder or face, not a sternal rub).

When performing moderate conscious sedation in support of other procedures which were not formerly listed in the 2016 CPT Appendix G:

- The new moderate sedation codes 99151-99157 are eligible to be separately reported – and reimbursed.
- Moderate sedation is not considered included in the reimbursement for procedures
