The Texas Academic Skills Program (TASP) Test was developed to gauge college-bound student competency in Reading, Mathematics, and Writing. As part of the TASP program, colleges and universities in Texas are required to offer their students advisory and support services related to the TASP Test and to develop and implement appropriate remedial activities for students who do not pass one or more of the three sections of the TASP Test.

The passing scores you receive on the TASP Test while in high school count toward meeting the TASP requirements for five years after you take the test if you do not enroll in college, or will count indefinitely if you enroll within a five-year period. The TAAS, or Texas Assessment of Academic Skills, was the third standardized test used in Texas between 1991 and 2002, when it was replaced by the TAKS test from 2003 to 2013. It was used from grades 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11. Passing the Grade 11 level was required for graduation, but many opportunities for retesting were available.

### High School Equivalency Exam | TASC test—moving you forward

The initial pass rates per section indicate that more students successfully completed the writing test (69.3%) than successfully completed the reading test (61.4%) or the math test (42.0%). White students performed best in writing (77.4%) and reading (71.3%). Asian students performed best in math (62.0%).

The TASP test measures skills in reading, mathematics, and writing and is administered according to published schedules. The TASP test cannot be used as a criterion for admission. Registration information regarding test dates and fees is available at Killam Library Room 214, provided by Programs for Academic Support and Enrichment (PASE).

**TEXAS ACADEMIC SKILLS PROGRAM (TASP)**

The science, social studies, math, and reading tests (before grade 9) consist of multiple-choice questions scored by computer. On each test, a scaled score of 2100 is required to pass and 2400 is required to earn "commended" status. Performance standards showing the raw scores are available online.
