**How to Make a Study Guide - An Easy & Effective Studying ...**  
A reading guide is simply a list of suggested topics for discussion, most often created by the publisher. Many books suitable for book clubs have reading guides - and a reading guide can be a good indicator of the book's suitability for discussion (i.e. the publisher has invested the time and money in creating a guide).

**Reading Group Guides**  
An anticipation guide is a comprehension strategy that is used before reading to activate students' prior knowledge and build curiosity about a new topic. Before reading, students listen to or read several statements about key concepts presented in the text; they're often structured as a series of statements with which the students can choose to agree or disagree.
